

# Erumely town in the grip of spiritual fervour

A spiritual frenzy has engulfed Erumely, the main base camp of Sabarimala pilgrims, with the town slated to host the ceremonial Petta Thullal by the Ambalappuzha and Alangad teams, preceded by the Chandanakkudam celebrations at the Nainar Mosque on Friday.

The celebrations also mark the final phase of this edition of the annual pilgrimage season at Sabarimala.

The Chandanakkudam celebrations, organised by the Erumely Mahallu Muslim Jama-at, will commence with a procession from the Nainar Mosque at 6:30 p.m. on Friday. Accompanied by percussion ensembles and art perfor-

mances, the procession will move around the town, receiving receptions at various points before concluding at the mosque the next day morning.

Devaswom Minister V. N. Vasavan will inaugurate a meeting to be held before the Chandanakkudam procession at 6:15 p.m., while Water Resources Minister Roshy Augustine will flag off the famed procession from the mosque's premises.

**Communal harmony**

The Chandanakkudam celebration is held annually to commemorate the unique bonhomie between Lord Ayyappa and his trusted Muslim lieutenant Vavar, reflecting the tradition of communal harmony in the region.

**Petta Thullal and Chandanakkudam celebrations to mark final phase of annual pilgrimage season at Sabarimala**

to Antony will inaugurate the reception for the Petta Thullal teams from Ambalappuzha and Alangad at a function presided over by Nazar Panachi, president of the Jama-at on Friday.

The festivities on Saturday will resume with teams from Ambalappuzha and Alangad, representing the maternal and paternal lineages of Lord Ayyappa, performing the spiritual dance.

The Ambalappuzha team is scheduled to begin their Thullal from the Kochambalam after the sight-

ing of the Brahminy Kite (Krishna Paranthu) in the skies at 11 a.m. The Alangad team will commence their dance in the afternoon after spotting the “star” in the day skies.

“The Petta Thullal teams, which will proceed through the forest route, will reach Sabarimala to perform the customary Pampavilak and Pampasadya rituals on January 13,” said P.S. Prashanth, president of the Travancore Devaswom Board.

**Movement regulation**

Meanwhile, the movement of pilgrims through the forest path will be regulated from Mukkuzhy between January 11 and 14 to facilitate the passage of the Petta Thullal teams. Other devotees arriving at Erumely will be redirected straight

to Pampa, according to Arun S. Nair, Additional District Magistrate, Sabarimala.

Given the heightened pilgrim activity over the next two days, an additional 100 police personnel will be deployed on duty, while traffic through the town will be regulated from Friday afternoon onward. Currently, 340 officials are on special duty for the two-month pilgrimage season.

Meanwhile, the steady influx of pilgrims en route to Sabarimala has caused the temple town to experience the biggest traffic snarls in its history. The ripple effects of these snarls are visible across the region, with serpentine queues stretching along the Sabarimala route on one side and up to Kanjirappally on the other.

## CPI(M) rebel is local body president

In a sign of growing discontent within the CPI(M) ranks in Pathanamthitta, a dissident leader who defied the party whip was elected president of the Thottappuzhassery grama panchayat on Thursday.

In an election held to the 13-member council of the local body, R. Krishnakumar, a CPI(M) rebel recently suspended from the party, secured seven votes, defeating the party candidate Ajitha T. George, who garnered only three votes.

Mr. Krishnakumar's victory was made possible with the support of four dissenting CPI(M) leaders, along with three Congress members.

# Irregularities found in distribution of e-grant in Idukki engg. college

The finance inspection wing under the Finance department has found huge irregularities in e-grant distribution at Government Engineering College in Idukki. The probe was initiated on Wednesday following a complaint.

According to sources, a college official reportedly changed the account numbers of eligible students and diverted the money to other accounts.

The government distributes e-grants to economically backward students. “In November last year, two students who were being transferred to another institution complained that they had not receive the grant money. A preliminary inspection by the college revealed that a staff member had submitted different account numbers and transferred the money to them,” said the source.

Though the college had alerted the State Technical Education department last November, they failed to

act on it. According to the source, in the initial inspection by the finance wing, embezzlement of over ₹2 lakh was found.

“We suspect it is just the tip of the iceberg. To know the full extent of the embezzlement, the wing must get the account details. The finance inspection wing has submitted a letter to the college authorities, requesting them to gather details of all student beneficiaries,” said sources.

Meanwhile, Pradeep M., administrative assistant of the college, said the college immediately alerted the State Technical Education department upon receiving a tip-off. “The technical education wing conducted an inspection in the college on Monday and Tuesday and submitted a report to the government. The team has also informed us that they will schedule another inspection on January 16 and 17,” said the official.

Sources allege that a college clerk, who had worked from 2019 to 2023, may have been responsible for the embezzlement.
